Section B: Transfers Between Approved Hospitals and Jurisdictions

- Patients can be transferred between approved hospitals with the approval of the Controlling Authority of each hospital. Once that agreement is provided the order takes effect as if it were made out to the hospital where the patient is being transferred.
- The Tribunal needs to be advised of any transfers so that the patient can be notified when the Tribunal will review their order. A patient who has been refused a transfer or who is unhappy with the decision to transfer them, can apply to the Tribunal for a review of the decision.
- Transfer from or to another jurisdiction means a transfer of a patient pursuant to an interstate agreement. This section of the Act has not yet come into effect.
